

Luka Modrić Scholarships

We award **70 scholarships** in total:

- **30 Bachelor program** scholarships with 100% tuition fee reduction for all eligible SSBM Geneva Bachelor programs
- **30 Master and MBA program** scholarships with 100% tuition fee reduction for all eligible SSBM Geneva Master and MBA programs
- **10 DBA program** scholarships with 100% tuition fee reduction for all eligible SSBM Geneva DBA programs



Scholarship Eligibility and Required Documents

Applicants must meet the standard admission requirements for the relevant program in addition to the scholarship-specific eligibility criteria. Scholarship awards are subject to verification of submitted documents, availability of scholarships, and final approval by the Scholarship Committee.

All submitted information and supporting documents are subject to verification by SSBM before and after the scholarship selection process. SSBM reserves the right to request additional documentation or contact relevant institutions, employers, or authorities to verify the authenticity and accuracy of the submitted materials.

If any information or document is found to be false, misleading, incomplete, altered, or fraudulent, the application may be rejected immediately or any awarded scholarship may be withdrawn at any time.

4. Scholarships are awarded to all candidates who meet the requirements of these regulations and apply for the scholarship.

6. The decision on the allocation of scholarships is made by the Dean of the school based on the evaluation committee's conclusions through a written decision. By the decision, the Dean announces the start of the competition, the end of the competition, the competition's predefined conditions, the number of scholarships, and the criteria for the allocation of scholarships/discounts.
7. Criteria and conditions for awarding points and scholarships are published on the school's notice board and website, available to all candidates.
8. Individual scholarships are for a maximum 100% discounts for each category. After the scholarship evaluation committee's decision, students can decide to apply for any programme of the schools with or without a discount.
9. The school's evaluation committee analyzes all received candidate scholarship applications, evaluates motivation letters, and other documentation for enrollment in accordance with the conditions of these regulations.

10. The school's evaluation committee for determining candidate scholarships has 3 school members nominated by the Dean.
11. Based on the determined candidate points for all scholarship criteria, a list of candidates with points to which each candidate is entitled is established.
12. To ensure the transparency of the scholarship competition, the school will publish a list of students with granted scholarships on the school notice board and will communicate in a transparent way to all candidates.
13. After the announcement of scholarship results, 7 days period is provided for candidate appeals and candidate consent for the granted scholarship.
14. After the appeal period and obtaining candidate consent, SSBM will sign a study contract with the student after granting scholarships.
15. The student must accept all the school's general study conditions; otherwise, scholarships will not be awarded.
16. The evaluation committee will respond to all appeals within 5 days, and if justified, consider such candidates for the scholarship.

- 10 DBA program scholarships with 100% tuition fee reduction for all eligible PSM Paris DBA programs

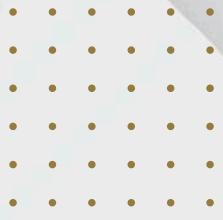

7. Criteria and conditions for awarding points and scholarships are published on the school's notice board and website, available to all candidates.
8. Individual scholarships are for a maximum 100% discounts for each category. After the scholarship evaluation committee's decision, students can decide to apply for any programme of the schools with or without a discount.
9. The school's evaluation committee analyzes all received candidate scholarship applications, evaluates motivation letters, and other documentation for enrollment in accordance with the conditions of these regulations.
10. The school's evaluation committee for determining candidate scholarships has 3 school members nominated by the Dean.

13. After the announcement of scholarship results, a 7-day period is provided for candidate appeals and candidate consent for the granted scholarship.
14. After the appeal period and obtaining candidate consent, PSM will sign a study contract with the student after granted scholarships.
15. The student must accept all the school's general study conditions; otherwise, scholarships will not be awarded.
16. The evaluation committee will respond to all appeals within 5 days, and if justified, consider such candidates for the scholarship.
